Travelling (1)



By plane:

The Vienna International Airport (VIE) is located in Schwechat, 16 kilometres from the city centre. There are direct flight connections to all major European cities.

The airport is connected to the city via public transport*:

- city airport train (CAT): The fastest connection from the airport to the city centre (Wien-Mitte). Non-stop, about 16 min, tickets can be bought directly on the airport, price one way 12 € per person
- airport bus: Various lines are connected to all metro-lines in Vienna. Busses are leaving every 30 minutes. For getting to the tournament hotels please take the line to Wien Westbahnhof and then switch to metro U6. Driving time is about 20 minutes, price one way per person 8 €.
- S-Bahn S7: Is the cheapest option to reach the city centre (Wien-Mitte). You can get there in about 20 minutes. Price per person one way is 4,10 €.

If you prefer to go by taxi, we recommend a so called “airport service”, which offers fixed prices. You can find a list of the offers here:

Travelling (2)

By car:

- Please keep in mind, that there is a busy traffic in the city.
- Please make sure to reach your start in time. Also please contact your hotel in advance concerning their parking facilities and prices.
- Important notice: The whole city area of Vienna is a short term parking zone Monday thru Friday from 9.00 – 22.00!

Parking:

- Plus Bowling Center: you can use the Interspar-Garage (access via Syringgasse), fee is 3,20 € for 5 hours or 6,40 € up to 10 hours (please ask at the Bowling centre for the reduction).
- Bowlingcenter Cumberland: free parking (limited parking space)

By train:

The central railway station (Wien Hauptbahnhof) is not in the centre of the city. From there you have to take taxi or public transport to reach your hotel.





Shuttle/public transport

There will be NO shuttle between the bowling centers.

Both centers are in a very short walking distance to the next U-Bahn station (metro/underground). It will take you about 30 min and just one change of trains to get from one center to the other.

For your stay in Vienna you can buy special unlimited tickets for the use of the public transport*:

24 hours – 8,00 €

48 hours – 14,10 €

72 hours – 17,10 €
